3. Dr Kershaw’s Hospice Lottery is promoted in accordance with the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 as amended (“the Act”). In order to comply with the Act during the operation of the Lottery you will be required to confirm that:
 - (a) You are at least 16 years of age.
 - (b) You are a resident of Great Britain.
 - (c) You will not buy or claim to buy lottery chances on behalf of any other person.

4. If, upon winning any prize in the Lottery, you are not able to prove that you have met the criteria specified in Clauses 3 (a) (b) and (c) above, then you will not be entitled to receive that prize.

5. In order to comply with the Act, refunds are prohibited once a purchase for a chance has been made.

6. Liability: Neither we nor any of our directors, trustees, governors, officers, employees or agents are liable for any kind of injury, loss or damage whatsoever, whether direct or consequential, suffered by any person or property arising out of or in connection with your use of this website.

- (b) Confirmation that you are over 16 years of age, in order to ensure compliance with the Lotteries and Amusements Act (1976) as amended.
- (c) Your contact telephone number.
- (d) Your e-mail address.
- (e) Your credit/debit card details or your bank details; these are to be used to process your membership payments.

By using the Lottery website, you consent to the collection and processing of your personal data when provided by yourself to us.

It is your responsibility to ensure that the personal information you provide to us is accurate.

Cancellation: You may cancel your membership at any time by contacting the Hospice. Remaining credits will keep your membership in play. Refunds will not be given for credits already made.
